

## **Description**

The aim of this camp is to confront young Europeans with important global issues regarding the European society. Discussions between the participants should encourage them to seek for ideas or even utopias needed in future to improve our coexistence despite various cultural backgrounds in Europe. Those ideas and utopias should be worked out in detail and finally visualized on paper. All final works then will be reproduced in a publication.

Beside the experience to work in a multidisciplinary team participants will also have the possibility to pro-actively contribute to the process of problem-solving through creative methods and to become part of an inspirational publication.

Each participant will have the possibility to create a two-dimensional work on paper using any preferred technique (drawing, writing, assembling,..) which will be presented on a maximum of two pages in the publication (24x28cm).

At the camp we will dispose of paper, pencils, colors, scissors, magazines, glue, cutters, water-colors, charcoal and ink. We will have the possibility to print and scan up to A3 format.

The publication will be sent, as it was the case with the ECC016 publication, to every head of state within the EU and to other important temporary stakeholders throughout the world. The whole project will be documented by photography and video.

The camp and our working spaces are located within the spaces of RAUM AU, separated spaces for men and women will be available. At the moment it is not accorded where we will shower, it will be at a nearby sports-hall or at the city swimming pool.
