WHAT DOES CREATIVITY MEAN?

TELL YOUR STORY:

THE SUCCESSFUL BOWLER IN ZABOK

Magdalena Škreblin, who is 18 years old, plays bowling and clarinet. She has a lot of medals for bowling and still represents Croatia for bowling. She decided to be a bowler at a birthday party in 2013. She started to play the Clarinet in 2012. Let's discover her sports journey.

First, can you introduce yourself?

My name is Magdalena Škreblin. I am 18 years old and studying at the School for arts, design, graphics, and clothes in Zabok. I just finished third grade for industrial design and I'm starting forth in September. I am also in music high school and I finished third grade, playing the clarinet.

How did you decide to play bowling as a professional?

I started bowling in 2013 after a birthday party I went to. The birthday was in a bowling alley. I fell in love with it. I was part of a Croatian representation in the last two world nine-pin bowling championships. Medals from those championships are my favourite. I won gold in a team for under 18 last year in Slovenia, Kranj, and a bronze this year in Elva, Estonia, also in a team in the under 23 category.

What do you do in your free time?

Besides practising, playing the clarinet and doing homework, I hang out with my family and friends, take walks, watch movies, read books, draw, volunteer and do lots of other things.

You said that you volunteer. What kind of volunteering do you do?

It depends, with DND I volunteered in "Zdravo i fino" - cooking and helping kids, with DND we were also painting walls in school, we do certain stuff like going to animal shelters, collecting bottle caps, making board games, making chairs from old tires.

How do you prepare yourself for bowling competitions? Can you describe your one day?

I do not have huge preparations for my competitions, I just try to take a good rest the day before and be calm, enjoy the moment and have fun. Every day of my week is different, but I have a routine. If my school starts in the morning, I would go to school then practice and after practice music school.

Do you have plans for the future? What would you like to do?

My plans after high school are to go to college and continue bowling.

What would you recommend for those who want to play bowling?

For someone who wants to try bowling, I would support and recommend trying it, it is fun and exciting and can also be played no matter the age.


Prvi dan - Aprilia

KREATIVNA RADIONICA

SHIBORI TEHNIKE

"Shibori – japanska riječ iza koje se krije tisućljeće razvijanja i usavršavanja tehnika, pomoću kojih bezlične tkanine dobivaju novi šarm, te nekoliko sati zabave u subotnje popodne."



Popularni sindrom „nemam ništa za obući“ imali smo čast doživjeti nekolicinu puta; ponekad i više puta tijekom istog dana. Dok naši ormari pucaju pod pritiskom silne odjeće koja, u mraku te drvene kutije, sniva vječni san na kojem bi joj i sama Trnoružica zavidjela, priroda je ta koja izvlači deblji kraj. Svi znamo da su divovi modne industrije poput ZARA-e, H&M-a i New Yorker-a, u priči o ekološkoj osviještenosti i spašavanju planeta, negativci! Također, znamo da na drugoj strani borbene linije stoje second hand-ovi i mali dućani koje često vode 1-2 osobe, a koje ponekad možemo pronaći samo u on-line formi. No osim rezuckanja i šaranja markerom za tekstil, kako pojedinac može nadići taj famozni „nemam ništa za obući“ sindrom, a da ne zakorači u zloglasni shopping centar? Bedekovčanska udruga mladih, u sklopu programa Mreže udruga Zagor "Centar u gostima" u subotu 23.7., ponudila je mladim ljudima jedno od rješenja – shibori!

Shibori – japanska riječ iza koje se krije tisućljeće razvijanja i usavršavanja tehnika, pomoću kojih bezlične tkanine dobivaju novi šarm, te nekoliko sati zabave u subotnje popodne. Postoji bezbroj načina za stvaranja uzoraka na tkanini – bilo koji način na koji se tkanina može saviti, šivati ili vezati, prije samog bojanja, postići će neki uzorak. No kako ipak ne bismo dobili preapstraktne uzorke, sudionici su se prvo upoznali s 4 osnovne shibori tehnike i uzorcima koji rezultiraju korištenjem istih.



Kanoko shibori najjednostavnija je i najpopularnija shibori tehnika. Ukoliko ste radili s tie-dye tenikom, utoliko vam ova tehnika neće biti apstraktna. Sve što trebate su nekoliko komada plastičnih gumica i možete krenuti u svoju shibori avanturu.



Arashi (jap. oluja) shibori poznatija je kao "pole-wrapping" tehnika jer se tkanina ovijava oko PVC cijevi ili staklene boce, a zatim se učvršćuje konopom. Ova tehnika svoje ime je dobila po krajnjem rezultatu koji nastaje na tkanini - dijagonalnim linijama koje podsjećaju na mlaz kiše usred oluje.



Itajime shibori tehnika je čiji su kranji rezultat na tkanini geometrijski oblici - trokut i kvadrat. Tradicionalno, tkanina se nalazi u "sendviču" između dva komada drveta koje na mjestu zadržavaju konopi.



Posljednja tehnika s kojom su se sudionici mogli upoznati bila je Kumo shibori. Ova tehnika uključuje stvaranja nabora na tkanini koji se potom vežu s nekolicinom gumica kako bi nastala "nožica". "Nožica" se često naziva i paukova noga jer krajnji rezultat podsjeća na paukovu mrežu.

CREATE A MAP FOR YOUR STORY

If you see the long text without visuals, will you read that article or will you ignore it?



Google Earth Studio Interface

Visualization plays an important role today. Readers want to see the visualization. Especially for journalists and storytellers, it is more important. I want to explain three websites for creating maps and I want to explain how you can use maps for your project.

GOOGLE EARTH STUDIO


Before Google Earth Studio, maybe I should explain Google Earth. [\(link\)](#) Google Earth is a map application developed by Google. It allows you to explore all the countries of the world through the world map. You can navigate around the world, click on a country and explore that country. You can navigate over countries in 2D and 3D. You can even see the streets of some cities thanks to the "Street View" feature. Google Earth is different from a classic map. The buildings, rivers, trees, and important historical places of the country/city are designed realistically and

you can see them while navigating the map. Google Earth is a good example of an interactive map.

Google Earth Studio [\(link\)](#) is an animation tool for creating animation maps. The data you see in Google Earth also appears in Google Earth Studio. But this time you can take a photo of this data or save it as a video. Google Earth Studio gives us this

information for free. But you have to cite the source. That's why you shouldn't delete the "Google Earth" name in the video.

First, you need to register with Google Earth Studio. Google will ask you why you want to use this app and will usually accept your request within a day if it sees fit. It is an easy tool to learn. If you want to shoot a

video on the map, you have to navigate over the map. If you want to go to a specific place, you can click on the magnifying glass icon and write the address you want to go to. You can change the view of the map. Generally, I prefer “exploration maps”.

If you want, you can also create the moon and Mars animation. But you can see just the moon and Mars’s surface.

When you finish your video, you can convert it to MP4. When you save your video, your video will be saved in the cloud of Google Earth. You should download it from the cloud.

KNIGHT LAB


Knight Lab ([link](#)) was created by the community of Northwestern University Knight Lab. There are designers, developers, students, and educators in this community. They created tools for storytelling. They have six tools for now: Storyline JS, Storymap JS, Juxtapose, Soundcite, Timeline and Scene VR. If you have a story and you want to try new things, these tools are great for you. These tools are so useful, especially for journalists. Because your story can be interesting but for readers, it is not enough. Also, readers want to see creative visuals.

My favourite map is **StoryMap JS**. Thanks to this tool, you can create a map and you can add your text. So, readers can read your text, navigate the location and see photos. You can choose your map style, add images, and specify your location. Knight Lab recommends short stories, for example, a maximum of 20 slides.

Another useful tool is **Storyline JS**. If you have data and want to ex-



Datawrapper Maps Interface

plain your story by specifying the years, you can use this tool. If you want to create a timeline, Knight Lab also has the **Timeline** tool. If you want to compare two photos and show the before and after of something, you can use **Juxtapose**. Also, you can create GIFs for your social media account owing to it. If you want to create VR (Virtual Reality), you can use **Scene VR**. You should use panoramic photos. First, you should log in to your Google Account. After log in, you can choose your title and description and add your photos. When you finish, you can get your VR embed link. The last tool is **Soundcite**. Honestly, I haven’t used it before. But if you want to add music to your text, you can use this tool. I think the idea is creative. Because voice can make your text more effective. Another good thing is in Knight Lab, they give examples of news from another newspaper. If you don’t have an idea about how you can use this tool, you can visit the Knight Lab website and you can check it out. You can see a lot of news from the Washington Post, The Times and more!

visualization. For charts and tables, you can upload your data as an XLS/CSV; you can use a link from Google Sheets or you can write your data manually. After data, you can visualize your data and choose your chart type. For mapping, Datawrapper has three types of maps. Choropleth, Symbol and Locator.

**I joined the “Maps for Journalists” workshop and Mesut Ersöz, who is a Motion Graphics Designer in the BBC, explained to us Google Earth Studio and Datawrapper. Inspired by the workshop, I decided to write this article. Thanks to the Journalists Union of Turkey Academy and Mesut Ersöz.*




