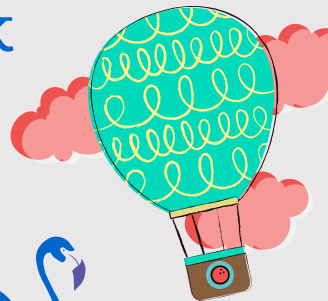
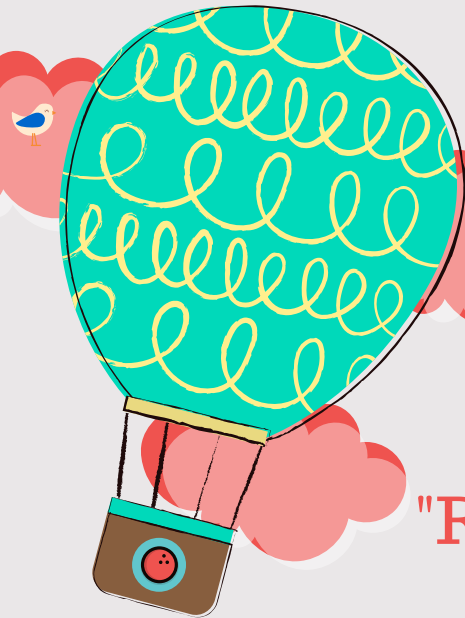

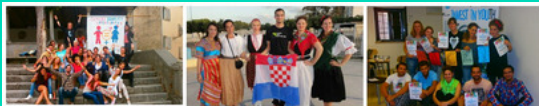
Who are we?

Project description



Project "Restart humanity!" is a training course embracing a very trending issue in Europe that includes discussion on human rights in context of refugees and non-violence. Project contributes to developing the quality of support systems for youth workers/teachers in field of human rights and the capabilities of civil society organizations/schools to promote human rights and conflict resolution. By using non formal education the activities tend to: Facilitate participants in the topic communication and conflict resolution techniques, Enhance knowledge about human rights in the doctrine of "Responsibility to Protect" (R2P) assuming existence of responsibility of members of the international community, the obligation to respond to mass violations of human rights, children's rights and in particular the rights of refugees, Enhance knowledge about the Rights of the Child and the Rights of Refugees, Present to participants programs of the Council of Europe and the European Commission which support activities promoting knowledge and raising the awareness on human rights among young people, Facilitate participants in specific methods and tools useful in the work of the Human Rights educator. This project will be focused on motivation, (self)-empowerment and civic courage so the participants will feel more self-secure and capable of taking initiatives in their organizations on the human rights topics.

Participants

This project involves 20 young people in total from Croatia, Serbia, Austria, Slovenia and Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. Each country will be represented by 4 participants (18+).

Project costs

This project is funded by Erasmus + programme, which means that there are 100% covered expenses for accommodation, food (3 meals per day + coffee breaks), programme, facilitators, materials. In this project the amount that was approved per person for travel is: for participants from Croatia is 80,00 euro, Slovenia and Austria 180,00 euro, Serbia and Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia 275,00 euro. Before buying the tickets all the participants need to consult with the hosting organization about travel plans. All participants must keep their original tickets and boarding passes in order to reimburse the tickets costs.





Project schedule



Training course is going to be held from 01st till 08th of September 2016. in the campsite Tunarica, Croatia. Therefore, it is really important to come on time regarding the schedule. Arrival date is 01st of September till lunch time (15:00 o'clock), and departure date is 08th of September 2016 after breakfast. Before starting the project please let us know the time of your arrival, as well as the time of your departure.

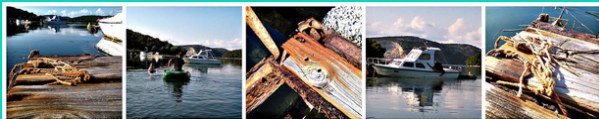
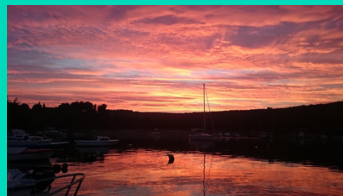

Project venue



The project will be held in campsite Tunarica from 1st till 8th September 2016. The campsite is located on the Eastern coast of Istria peninsula of Croatia, about 17 km from Labin and about 60 km from Pula airport. This attractive, natural bay, protected from all winds, is more than ideal for a training. It amidst unspoilt scenery and deep blue sea, and offers beautiful woodland and rich vegetation, opportunities to relax and its unspoilt tranquility. It covers the area of a small green peninsula sticking out of the eastern coast of Istria, 17 km outside Labin and about 60 km from Pula airport.





Accommodation

Training course as well as participants accommodation will be situated in the campsite Tunarica. Participants will be sleeping in the tents (max. four people per tent) with sleeping bags.

Our training will be placed in the private place in the campsite with: Activities area – indoor and outdoor places for activities: workshops and sport

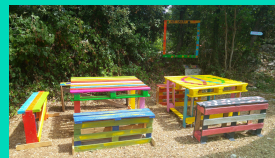
Meals area - a place where all meals are served

Food



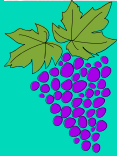
